Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 (Regulation GG)

The Department of the Treasury and the Federal Reserve Board issued Regulation GG, the Prohibition on Funding Unlawful Internet Gambling, to implement the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 and the updated law is known as the Internet Gambling Regulation, Consumer Protection and Enforcement Act.

The Act prohibits any person engaged in the business of betting or wagering from knowingly accepting payments in connection with the participation of another person in unlawful Internet gambling. The Act defines 'unlawful internet gambling' as placing, receiving or otherwise knowingly transmitting a bet or wager by any means that involves the use, at least in part, of the Internet where such a bet or wager is unlawful under any applicable Federal or State law in the State or Tribal Lands in which the bet or wager is initiated, received, or otherwise made.
